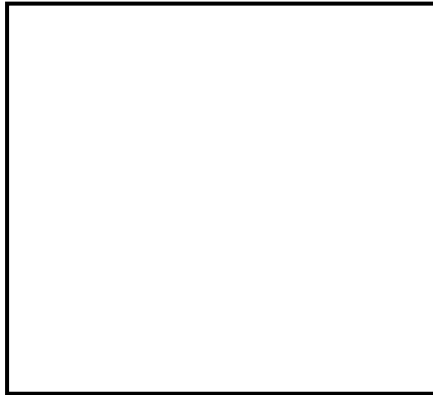

## Roman ranks

Imperator / Commander

Legates (legati) - Lieutenants who frequently commanded  
separate legions

The Quaestor who was charged with the care of the  
military chest and the supplies

Centurions - the captain

Immunes - Soldiers with special skills

Evocati - Veteran soldiers

Beneficarii - the orderlies

Coniceni - The musicians

Munifex - The Roman Soldiers - the lowest ranks  
equivalent to privates
