Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to welcome you to Snaith Primary School and to offer more information with regard to the organisation for your child starting school in September.

Our Reception team will consist of two parallel Reception classes, one staffed by Mrs McDermott/Mrs Johnson class teachers, supported by Mrs Spencer and the other by Mrs Hyland class teacher, supported by Mrs McKiernan.

It is very important to us that this special time of starting primary school is calm, smooth and one where you and your child feel happy and supported.

With this in mind we would like to invite you to attend a Parents Information Evening on: Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

The evening will start at 6.00pm (we anticipate the meeting may take about an hour to an hour and a half). We will meet in the school hall to share important information with you and meet the team, followed by an opportunity to visit the classrooms. **This visit is primarily for parents, as we have lots to share. Please see below for visits with your child.**

On this evening school book bags and PE bags will be available to purchase. We strongly recommend that children have these items, or equivalent to transport their letters, reading books and wonderful work to share with you. We will be offering these at a reduced cost of £5.00 for school bags and £3.50 for PE bags. (The prices are greatly subsidised by School Funds)

The PTA will also be there with a preloved uniform sale.

### MAKING THE BEST START IN SEPTEMBER

We appreciate that starting school can feel a little daunting for you and your child and we aim to make this transition to full time education a happy and smooth one. Therefore, we will be organising the start to the new school year as follows.

- **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September** - we are inviting you and your child to visit school for an hours stay and play session to enable your child to become familiar with their new class and surroundings. **Please contact the school office 01405 860452 to book your day and time.**



- **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September to Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September** children will **arrive at 9am** and leave before lunch at **11:45am**
- **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> September and Friday 16<sup>th</sup> September** – children to **arrive 9am** and leave after lunch at **1.30pm**
- **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September onwards children will attend full days.**  
The times of the school day from this point will be – **8.55am to 3.30pm (School gates open from 8.45am)**

In our experience, this gradual introduction will help everyone to settle into school life in a relaxed way.

We are currently creating some welcome videos for your child to watch, to introduce them to their teachers. We look forward to sharing these with you at the welcome meeting when you will also find out which class your child will be in.
