#### **Childcare Voucher Payments**

All childcare voucher payments have now been put onto the gateway system and should be showing on the app. If you have made a payment and cannot see it please contact the school office.

If you pay via the Government Tax Free Childcare system, please can you email the office with the child's name and reference, the exact amount and the date paid, every time you make a payment this way. Otherwise we cannot match the payments on their system.

Also, anyone who uses both before and after school clubs and pays using any kind of tax free childcare payment, please can you let me know how you would like the payments to be split. Otherwise we will use our best judgement. Please ensure B/ASC payments for July are paid up to date. A reminder that September sessions will be due for payment by 10<sup>th</sup> October – an invoice will not be sent out.

Reminder that Before school club and After school club are separate on the app. Please check both as these are payable separately.

# Uniform

Please can I remind everyone about the importance of labelling uniform, even if this is just hand written in the label. (However, this does wash out overtime). We have had many items lost and found this week. Any items found that day will be placed in the shelter for collection.

#### **Tissues**

Last year we requested that children should bring their own tissues to school in their school bag. I would once again like to reiterate this, as the cost of tissues has doubled! This greatly impacts our school budget which we cannot sustain. I therefore urge you to provide your child with their own tissues especially when your child has a cold or suffers from hayfever/allergies.
