# WWII

WOW! What amazing memories we have made together on our WWII theme day. The children looked incredible in their outfits – thank you so much. What a tremendous effort everyone went to (including staff). The day started with Drill on the yard followed by the air raid sounding – our cue to rush inside. Then, throughout the day, Squadron X, along with the two sheep, shared so much with the children. This included learning about animal welfare during WWII (there were some surprising facts revealed), military wear and items, entertainment in the form of music and dancing of the time, and numerous artefacts for the children to handle and learn about. Thank you also to everyone who so kindly sent in your own WWII treasure, from an incubator for babies, to gas masks, to precious medals, very proudly shared along with the stories of those they belonged to. We were also visited by Chris from WWI Research Group who shared his knowledge of WWI with the children, sharing lots of memorabilia. The children very much enjoyed all the super artefacts. Our WWII lunch was also fantastic. (Although, we are not that old, a few of us remembered how much we actually enjoyed carnation milk!) Our day ended with a rousing speech from Sir Winston Churchill and wonderful sing song in the hall finishing with 'We'll Meet Again'.

Throughout all of this time the children demonstrated such enthusiasm and polite manners and the visitors said that the memories the children had created for them would stay with them for the rest of their lives. We are now working to put a collection of pictures of the day together for you to enjoy.

We would also like to extend our thanks to members of Pollington Historical Society who started off our week with a fantastic assembly about Pollington Airfield, the experience of evacuees who came to Snaith (their names are in the school's admission book of the time) and what life was like for children at the time, including games, rationing and sweets!
