#### Spring Term

A very happy new year to all of our families. We are all looking forward to a wonderful term ahead. This term we continue to focus on writing as one of our key school development actions.

#### Parking

We pride ourselves on having a good relationship with our local residents on the adjoining roads and cul-de-sacs near to the school. During drop off and pick up times the roads around school can become very busy, we therefore ask for you to be mindful and considerate about where you park when dropping off and picking up from school and avoid blocking driveways/parking bay, parking on the pavements and near to junctions. Access is required for residents and emergency vehicles at all times.

The layby in front of school is for **drop off only**, please do not park here to watch your child walk into school. We also politely request that car owners kindly **turn off their engines** whilst parking/waiting along Bourn Mill Balk Road at the start or end of the school day due the amount of fumes that are circulating, especially where people are waiting along the footpath. (Hopefully this would also help save some fuel too!) Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.

#### PE/Ear Tape

If you child has pierced ears, we ask that they remove these for PE lessons. If the ears are newly pierced we ask for these to be covered over with microporous tape. If your child requires this, please send it to school in their bag. Thank you.

# Swimming Lessons Year 4.

Following the Easter Holidays, Year 4 and some Year 5 children will be having swimming lessons at Askern Leisure Centre. With this in mind, please **do not** arrange for your child to have their ears pierced within 6-8 weeks prior to the lessons commencing as these can-not be removed due to the healing time required and therefore your child will not be able to attend lessons. The Leisure Centre recommends that no earrings be worn. If your child is unable to remove their own earrings please remove these at home, unfortunately, we are not able to assist with this in school and could result in your child missing their lesson.

Further details of the swimming lessons will be communicated later this term.

# **Before and After School Club**

Sessions can now be booked through to the end of Term (22<sup>nd</sup> March). There has been a small price increase from the beginning of January and this is shown on the system. Please note that all sessions up to the end of December should now be paid.
