Arbor Parent Reminder

Please ensure your child's Arbor profile is kept up to date, including:

- Home address
- Contact details
- Medical information
- Dietary requirements
- Consent preferences, including photographs

Accurate information helps us keep your child safe and ensures we can contact families when required.

Wraparound Care

Our wraparound provision remains extremely popular and advance booking is essential.

Please ensure:

- All required sessions are booked via Arbor.
- To check if your child is booked in, go to each child's calendar in Arbor.
- Contact the school office if a session is full, we will try to accommodate or add to a waitlist.
- If children are not booked in, and we do not have space, you will be called to collect them from school.
- Inform the office if your child will not attend an after-school session, including absence due to illness.

Cancellations made more than 48 hours in advance will not be charged. Cancellations within 48 hours will still incur charges.

- An Exceptional Circumstances Request Form must be completed for all non-medical absences.
- Penalty notices will be issued for unauthorised leave.
- Attendance below 97% becomes a concern.
- Attendance below 90% is classed as persistent absence.
